

Flying home at the end of your cruise

A taxi rank for taxis back to the airport is located outside each cruise terminal. Taxis may be very busy while the ships are disembarking so you may choose to pre-book (e.g. Tel. Checker Cars on 023 8062 7100).

Time on your hands?

Cruise passengers often find that they have several hours between disembarking in the morning and checking-in for their flight home.

The airport terminal has plenty of seating, catering and a branch of WH Smith. However, if you're not quite ready to get out of holiday mode just yet, we have the solution!

Located in the main terminal, the Left Luggage Facility is a short duration secure luggage holding facility for customers wishing to leave the airport and return later.

Items are charged at £5.00 each per day.

TAXI

Checker Cars Taxi Desk is located within the airport terminal. Pre-booking is recommended to speed your journey through at busy times. Please call 023 8062 7100 or visit www.checkercars.com

- Taxi journey time: Approx. 20 minutes
- Cost: £19.50*



TRAIN

Southampton Airport has one of the closest train-to-plane connections in Europe, with Southampton Airport (Parkway) rail station just 99 steps from the terminal.

Trains run up to every 15 minutes from Platform 2 to Southampton Central station, from where you can get a taxi to your cruise terminal.

- Train journey time: Approx. 8 minutes (not including 2 mile taxi journey from rail station to cruise terminal)
- Cost: £2.70* single (not including taxi fare)

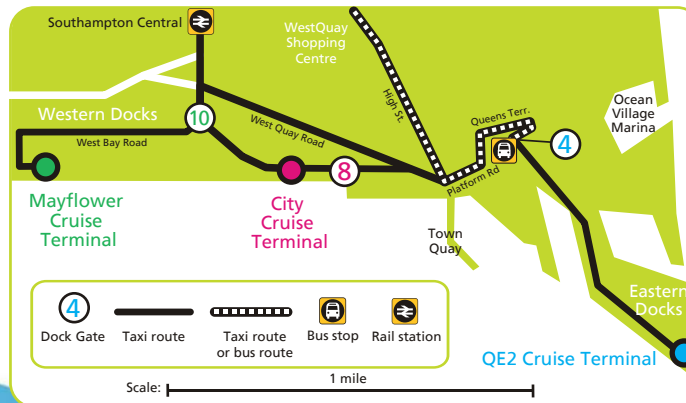


BUS

Catch uni-link buses from the airport terminal for Dock Gate 4 (For security purposes, passengers must alight at the Dock Gate 4 bus stop in Platform Road and walk 3/4 mile to the QE2 Cruise Terminal. See map below).

- Bus journey time: Approx. 50 minutes
Route U1C buses (to Southampton City Centre) and Route U1A buses (back to the Airport) run up to every 15 minutes
- Cost: £1.50* single

*All prices quoted are correct at July 2008 but may be subject to change.
Note: Taxis are permitted entry to Dock Gates 4, 8 & 10 on cruise days.
